수업개요		The aims of this course are twofold: (1) to give students a grounding in comedy theory with particular reference to the comedy and culture of the United Kingdom, and (2) to engage with the culture and society of the United Kingdom through the lens of comedy. Students will study various comedic forms - notbaly irony, black humour and satire - and link these with wider socio-cultural themes (gender, the class system, politics, sexuality, and so on). Students will be provided with a wide range of primary sources from the contemporary British comedic canon (the sitcom, the panel show, 'spontaneous' satire, 'anti' comedy, and so on). Through a reading of contemporary comedy, students will question and critique the pervasiveness of humour in daily British life; the use of irony, understatement, self-deprecation, and how these inform the British character.								
		To expose students to a wide range of contemporary British comedy.  To engage with comedy in a meaningful way, utilizing secondary sources from a variety of cultural disciplines (psychoanalysis, anthropology, deconstructionism, cultural theory).
