강의개요 (Course Description)	This course covers a variety of financial markets and institutions. Though the course's first goal is to introduce types and functions of financial markets and institutions, the course also explains the differences between them and the why of intermediation, etc. Understanding, instead of simple knowledge, of the basic principles about financial markets and institutions will help the students prepare for the inescapable volatility of the future, since the functional foundations on which financial markets and intermediaries are built will remain basically the same. Because of this analytical feature, students are highly recommended to take financial management and micro-economics in advance.
