	1. Title: Interactive Reading Based Instruction					
	2. Description					
	- focuses on active engagement in reading short articles (stories, novels, news, etc.)					
	within a small group. It trains students to listen actively, read silently and practice					
	repeated reading. It exposes students to shared reading where they read aloud,					
	explain what they read, share their background knowledge and or give their					
	opinions related to what they read, and ask questions to facilitate group discussion.					
	3. Teaching Materials					
강좌개발	3.1 Reading materials					
계획 및 전략	The reading materials are mainly short articles from <i>Reading for the Real World 2</i> .					
	(It is highly recommended to choose stories that are interesting and are tailored to					
	students' level of English reading and comprehension skills.)					
	3.2 Pre-reading worksheet					
	- includes title of the story, name of characters, and summary of the story –					
	beginning, middle, and end. Students should write the necessary information on the					
	blank space provided in the worksheet. (Instructors can also change the summary -					
	beginning, middle and end with problem and solution, ending and new ending,					
	depending on the context of the reading material)					



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3.3 Post-reading worksheet

- includes the revision of the students' pre-reading worksheet, taking into consideration instructor's notes or comments.

3.4 Vocabulary and sentence worksheet

- includes ten unfamiliar words from the reading material. Students are asked to write each word on the space provided in the worksheet and provide its meaning and use each word to make a sentence. Students are encouraged to make a long sentence, for example a sentence which is composed of at least eight words.

3.5 Portfolio

- includes students' compilation of all the materials they completed in the class. It should have a table of contents with a title of each activity and the date it was completed.

4. Assessment Forms

- 4.1 **Reading Speed Form** a record of how many times a student read a reading material and how many minutes it took him/her to read it
- 4.2 Reading Progress Self Assessment Form a record of how students think and feel about his/her reading progress

4.3 Reading Progress Assessment Rubric

- includes scale such as rate, phrasing, intonation, stress amn integration to assess students' reading progress

5. Instructional Design

5.1 Before class

1) Distribution of Homework

- Students are given a reading material ranging from 435 to 704 words, a reading speed form, pre-reading questions, a pre-reading worksheet, and a vocabulary and sentence worksheet.

2) Reading Recording through Kakao Talk

- Students are asked to record their reading in Kakao talk voice recorder, write down on the reading speed form how many minutes it took them to read , and send the voice recording through Kakao talk a day before the class starts.

3) Completion of all worksheets

- Students should complete all the worksheets before coming to class.

5.2 During Class



	1) Grouping students (3 min) - students are divided into four or five groups with					
	three or four members. Choosing a leader is recommended for better participation.					
	2) Listening, Silent Reading, Repeated reading (10 min) - students listen to the					
	audio material while reading the text silently, after that they read the text aloud					
	together with the audio material					
	3) Pre-reading Question Discussion (7 min)					
	- students discuss the prereading questions					
4) Shared Reading (25 min)						
	- Each student reads a paragraph aloud to his group members, explain what he/she					
	reads, share his background knowledge about the text and/or give his/her opinions,					
	and ask questions to facilitate group discussion. Each student follows the same					
	steps until they finished the assigned reading.					
	- Students are free to ask questions or share ideas or experience related to the					
	story.					
	- The instructor goes around the class to monitor group's performance and assist					
	each group if there are questions that cannot be answered by the members of the					
	group.					
5) Answering of Reading Exercises (5 min)						
	- students answer a 2 page reading exercises					
	6) Whole Group Discussion (10 min)					
- the instructor explains the main content of the reading ,materi						
	member of each group to share their group's answers on the pre-reading questions					
to the whole class.						
	5.3 After Class and Before the Next Class Starts					
	1) The instructor returns class worksheets that the students completed with some					
	notes or comments.					
	3) Students revise their pre-reading worksheet and vocabulary and sentence					
	worksheets and submit them back to the instructor					
	4) Students compile all their class materials in a portfolio.
