It includes a study of the media on US foreign policy. It highlights relationship of social movements and interest groups to US foreign policy. It concludes with a final focus again on US national security and defense policy. It also includes US economic statecraft in international relations. It conclude with a focus on US foreign policy and transnational global policy issues.
